### **Guidance System in Poland**

 Vocational guidance in Poland is based upon a doctrine according to which the process of human being's vocational career planning and development starts in early childhood and lasts the whole life period.

# Two ministers are responsible for vocational guidance in Poland:

- the Minister of National Education
- the Minister of Labour and Social Policy

## Vocational guidance in the Ministry of Education

- Vocational guidance tasks are performed in the Ministry of National Education by psychological and pedagogic services.
- 560 Psychological and pedagogical counselling centres function presently in Poland, including 26 special services focused on assisting youth in the choice of occupation.

# The main activities carried out by the centres include:

- gathering and providing access to educational and vocational information,
- diagnosing intellectual capacity, skills, vocational interests and preferences with the use of various measurement tools, paper and instrumental tests,
- issuing opinions for upper secondary schools in the case of candidates with health problems,
- issuing opinions on the need for special education of disabled students applying to general, special and integrated upper secondary schools,
- activities addressed to groups of students at different levels of education, including lectures, workshops, surveys regarding selection of school and vocation,
- activities addressed to parents, including counselling, consultations and lectures.

# Schools and educational institutions may employ vocational counsellors. The tasks of vocational counsellors and teachers performing their tasks include e.g.:

- systematic diagnosing of the students' need for educational and vocational information, as well as for assistance in planning further education and career,
- gathering, updating and providing access to educational and vocational information relevant for respective levels of education,
- providing students and parents with individual consultations,
- conducting activities that prepare students for planning career and taking up vocation in a well-considered manner,
- coordination of information and counselling activity carried out by the school or institution,
- cooperation with other teachers in creating and ensuring continuity of actions regarding vocational counselling.

### Certain schools offer the so-called School Career Centres (*Szkolne Osrodki Kariery, SzOK*).

#### They implement the following tasks:

- conducting courses on vocational qualifications,
- informing on health requirements and contraindications in specific industries and at specific positions,
- group diagnosing of important skills in professional life,
- providing information about the local and regional labour market,
- providing assistance in preparation of application documents,
- lectures and workshops on interpersonal skills,
- informing on recognition of education in Poland and abroad.
