- known as bishop's centre
- also known for its horse stables



-a settlement here existed from Roman times named Certissa, and the beauty of this region has delighted the Roman emperor Marcus Aurelius Probus, who had vineyards planted here in 277 AD





Cathedral The **Đakovo** Cathedral of St. Peter, build in the neoromanesque style was the seat of **Đakovo**srijem diocese



 in Ivandvor near Dakovo, the parent herd of mares is located together with offspring that are bred here until the third year, when male foals are relocated to the training center in stable Dakovo



A large number of Lipizzan horses from our Paddock are proudly entitled European champion, which is why Queen Elizabeth II. decided to personally visit the paddock and Ivandvor in 1972
