
GUIDANCE SYSTEM IN GREECE







Guidance for students is directed and organized by the Ministry of Education

Guidance for adults is directed and organized by the Ministry of Labour

8th- 9th grade – last of obligatory education- one hour per week Guidance by trained teachers in the curriculum.

Career Guidance Offices in every Region give students the chance to fill questionnaires about their interests and skills, so as to decide future professional fields.

Visits to Vocational Lyceums and Laboratories

(Career days - one day lyceum students).

They can also decide whether to follow General or Vocational education.

1st class in Lyceum

Career Guidance offices in every Region give students the chance to fill questionnaires to decide whether to go on with General or Vocational Education.

Visiting Vocational Lyceum (EPAL), Vocational schools (EPAS) laboratories allow them to make decisions about specialty choice.

3rd (last) class in Lyceum

Career Guidance Offices in every Region where students fill questionnaires about their future Jobs according to their skills.

Career days are organized where professionals present various professions.

Visits to enterprises help them to get familiar with professional environment.

3rd (last) class in Lyceum

Career Guidance Offices in every Region give instructions about CV and job interviews.

Higher Education School organize events for future students.
