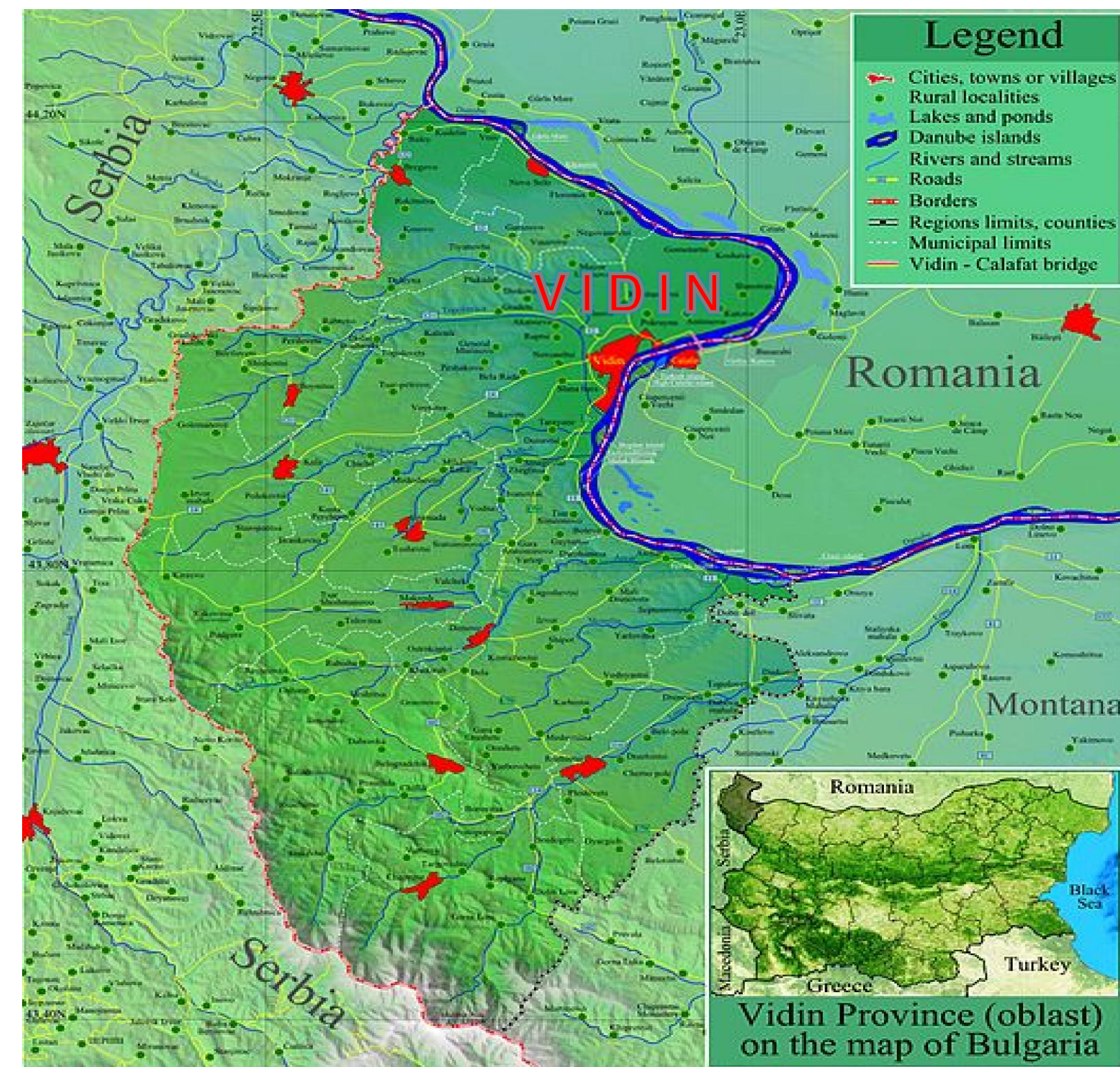

Vidin

- Vidin is small, but very beautiful town in Bulgaria.
- Vidin is a port town on the Danube river in northwestern Bulgaria. It is close to the borders with Serbia and Romania.
- Vidin is administrative centre of Vidin region.
- Vidin has got 47 138 people.



Vidin is a town with ancient history. It is established in the remote past. Vidin emerged at the place of an old Celtic settlement known as Dunonia, where the Romans built a fortress town called Bononia. Bulgarians called it Bdin and later Vidin.



Vidin have two well-preserved medieval fortresses, Baba Vida and KaletO. Another tourist attraction are The Synagogue, The ethnographical museum "The cross barracks", Pazvantoglu's mosque and library, The history museum – Konaka and "St.Dimitar" Church.





Another tourist attraction in Vidin area: **BELOGRADCHIK ROCKS**

Belogradchik Rocks have been nominated as one of the new seven wonders of nature in the world.

Many rocks have fantastic shapes and are associated with interesting legends.



MAGURA CAVE



Magura Cave is one of the biggest in the country. Some of the halls are with colossal dimensions as the biggest one is the Triumph hall with length of 128m, width – 58m. The cave have fantastic formations - stalactites, stalagmites, stalctones, cave pearls, “cave milk”. Some of them are impressive both with their beauty and size. “The Big Stalctone” is over 20m high and has a diameter of 4m at its base. On the cave's walls can be seen cave paintings dating from the late Neolithic Age
